The only camp dedicated specifically to children with cancer and their families, Leucan was set up in 1985. In 2001, it was renamed *Camp Vol d'été Leucan-CSN*, thanks to the partnership established with the Confédération des syndicats nationaux (CSN), which finances it through a number of fund-raising activities.

For Leucan families, the camp is an opportunity to have a real vacation and to forget illness at least for a little while. It is adapted to their realities and needs, offering a medical team that is present on site for the entire length of the camp. The team can administer oncological treatment and care for children that need it.
