My name is Cheikh Fall.

I am a young entrepreneur and also an employee of Bridor. For four years I have been president of a union with about 300 members, who chose me in late 2018 although I didn't campaign for the position. Since then, the true bonds of fellowship have deepened amongst us and have spread out to my connection with my central council (the Conseil central de la Montérégie) and my federation (the Fédération du commerce).

A month ago, we emerged from an indefinite general strike/lockout that lasted almost three months with a resounding victory and a significant improvement in our working conditions. The disappearance of racial and community divides since I became President has helped the union build strong bargaining and mobilizing leadership. I believe I have a gift for bringing people together!

I am a candidate of hope, a candidate of motivation for young union members, a candidate of communities of all backgrounds. My candidacy proves that at the CSN, the struggles we wage and the slogans we proclaim aren't just words but an internal reality—a reality that makes it possible for a young black man from an immigrant background, and of the Muslim faith to boot, to run for the highest office in the CSN. Mine is also a candidacy that removes any suspicion or false perception that power does not reside in the assembly of members.
